



# Change of Circumstances

What are some of the reasons a child support order may change?




# Review of Information

- Current Income
- Visitation Records
- Health Insurance Coverage
- Other Information as requested by the LCSA



# Results of the Review

- 20% or \$50 whichever is less
  - The change in support is reasonably expected to last more than three months
- Notification of review results
  - No change of circumstance
  - Not justified



# Stipulation and Order

- If the parties agree
- Commissioner signs Stipulation and Order
- Order/Notice to Withhold Income for Child Support form
- National Medical Support Notice form



# Court Hearing

LCSEA must file a motion for modification if the requesting party or nonrequesting party object to any part of the proposed child support amount
