The purpose of this letter is to ensure that each local child support agency (LCSA) Web site has prominently posted links to the state Web site pursuant to Senate Bill (SB) 84, chaptered on August 24, 2007. Specifically, the Department of Child Support Services (DCSS) requests that the following updated link be used for this purpose:

LCSA Letter 02-44 dated December 17, 2002 set forth minimum standards for LCSA Web sites, which includes a link to the DCSS Web site. SB 84 adds Section 17601 to the Family Code that now requires DCSS to provide to the Legislature comparative performance data each quarter, to post the data on its Web site, and to require all LCSA Web sites to post a link to the state (DCSS) Web site.

We request that all LCSAs review and update their Web sites to prominently display the above link to DCSS' Web site by November 30, 2007.
